Bonnie Slater of B & C Salon shares her thank you certificate with customer Shannon Dellinger. For years, Bonnie has donated a prize for our fundraisers



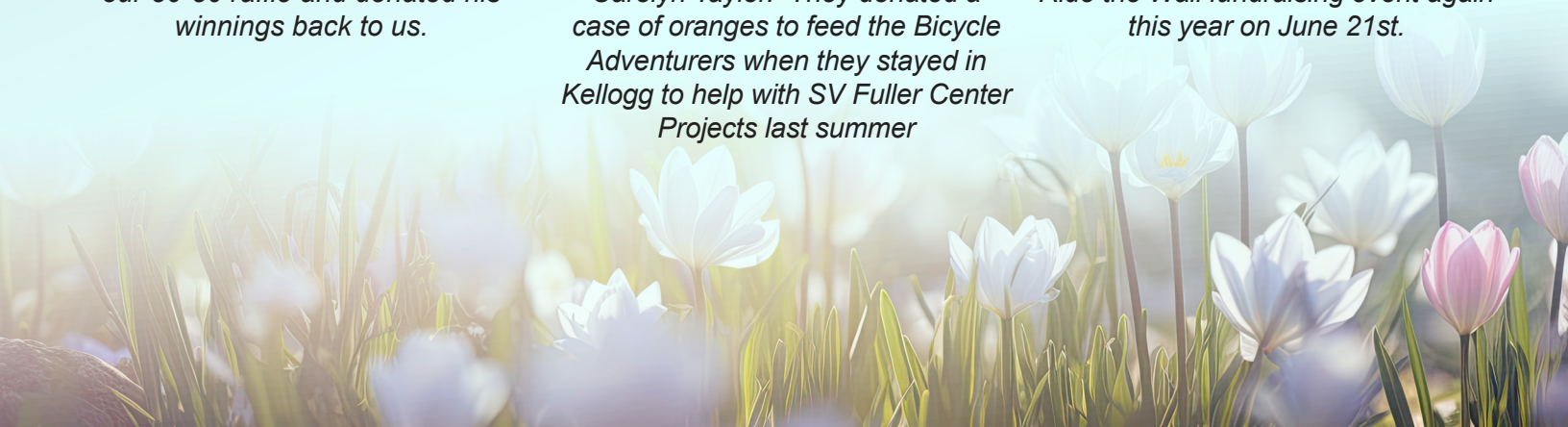
